Since the inaugural tour he has had an integral role in the organisation and deployment of a further 14 international tours to many parts of the world where the Koalas have been applauded for their unique style that reflects their motto "Entertainment on the Move".

For his contribution to music and the arts he received an Order of Australia Medal in Queen Elizabeth 11 Honours Awards in 2006. Geoff is currently the Band Manager of the Koalas and actively promotes the band locally and internationally.
